## 2017 APPLICATION FOR POOL PASS

The 2016 pool season will begin Saturday, May 27, 2017 and end Sunday, September 10, 2017. Pool passes will be issued to residents beginning Monday, May 8, 2017, but only if the LTC Office receives a completed pool application, and signed "Release, Waiver and Hold Harmless Agreement." Return the completed application to the Lakeside Terrace Office (7501 Democracy building lobby) along with your pool passes from last season. If you are a new resident, the condo office will issue you a new pass. Replacement passes are available for a nominal charge.

We would like to remind residents that the swimming pool is for the exclusive enjoyment of RESIDENTS and GUESTS ONLY. Everyone must comply with public law, the Bylaws, and Rules and Regulations for Lakeside Terrace.

### Admittance Procedures

Every resident entering the pool area must present to the lifeguard a current Lakeside Terrace Condominium pool or guest pass. Pool identifications are not transferable. Any card used by a person, other than the one to whom it was assigned, will be confiscated for the remainder of the calendar year. Each card is validated yearly. Lost cards will be replaced for a nominal charge. The unit owner as specified in 93(f) must accompany guests. A tenant, whose name is validated by a lease (and their children) will be issued a pool pass. All others are considered guests, and must use a guest pass per rule 93(f). Children under three are not permitted in the main pool at any time.

### Residents

All residents and their children will be admitted to the pool without charge. Minor children of residents, including grandchildren, are considered residents whether or not actually a resident in the unit. Children under 8 years of age must have an adult present at the pool at all times. Children 8 to 14 years of age will be allowed at the pool without an adult present, but only if the parent(s) accept the waiver on page three (3). Grandchildren of residents are considered resident children for purposes of the rules, but a waiver is still required for children 8-14 years of age who desire to swim at the pool without an adult present (signed waiver required).

### Guests

Guests of residents may also use the pool without charge. Guest passes may be issued by the Office Manager, on request of the owner or tenant. The passes are good for the length of stay of houseguests residing with the resident overnight. Guests not staying the night, or without such passes, are admitted only if accompanied by a resident with a pass. The number of guests is limited to four per unit at any time. Children will be admitted as per Rule 93d of the Lakeside Terrace Rules and Regulations. No guest under 14 years of age is permitted at the pool without an adult present at all times. All guests must complete and sign the "Release, Waiver and Hold Harmless Agreement," available from the lifeguard at the pool.

### Lifeguard Authority

The lifeguard is the person immediately responsible for the safety of the pool and pool area. All persons using the pool must comply immediately with requests or orders from the lifeguard. The lifeguard may give a swim proficiency test. Any person, regardless of age, may be required to demonstrate to the lifeguard swim proficiency, sufficient in the lifeguard's judgment, to assure the swimmer's safety. This also means that swim proficiency for children 8 to 14 years of age may be tested by the lifeguard to assure the child can safely swim at the pool without an adult present. If the child fails the swim test, the child will need an adult present while at the pool.

## Family Members

In addition to the co-owner or tenant names supplied on page one (1), and as a resident of Lakeside Terrace Condominium, I request additional pool pass for the following family members **RESIDING IN MY UNIT**. Please list **all children in your condominium unit** (young grandchildren should be listed as well). Parents should complete the *Child Swim Release Form* on page three, if the child is 8 to 14 years of age, and the parent gives their permission to allow a child to swim at the pool without a parent or adult guardian present. A swim test (administered by the lifeguard) may be required to validate this permission! If the lifeguard issues a swim test for your child, and your child fails this test, this permission will be invalidated and an adult will be required to be present with your child while at the pool. Please consult the lifeguard if this occurs.

## Acknowledgement

I have received, read, and understand the 2017 Swimming Rules and Regulations for Lakeside Terrace Condominium (**See Lakeside Terrace Rules and Regulations Section XXII, Effective 03/2006**). Co-owners, tenants, parents, and family members agree to abide by the Rules and Regulations of Lakeside Terrace Condominium. Any infringement of these rules may result in revocation of swimming privileges for the season. To allow **UNACCOMPANIED RESIDENT CHILDREN OR GRANDCHILDREN**, 8 to 14 years of age to swim at the LTC pool without a parent or adult guardian present, the “*Child Swim Release Form*” on page 3 must be completed also. **NO GUEST** under 14 years is permitted to swim at the pool unless accompanied by a resident adult. Children under 3 years are not permitted in the main pool at any time. While at the pool, it is important that all residents and guests obey all signage!

# CHILD SWIM RELEASE FORM

All parents must complete this form if you have resident children 8-14 years of age, and desire to grant them permission to be at the pool without an adult present. This permission is subject to a swim test given by the lifeguard. If the child cannot pass the swim test, the lifeguard may invalidate your permission and require an adult to be present with the child while at the pool. Should questions arise, parents should discuss this with the lifeguard directly.

## Agreement

I understand that the pool rules for Lakeside Terrace Condominium (LTC) allow RESIDENT children 8-14 years of age the ability to swim at the pool without a parent or adult guardian present. By signing this agreement, you agree to allow your child(ren) this privilege. Please provide all information required for each child. A notation will be placed on the child's pool pass indicating your approval. The lifeguard will verify this notation on the pool pass when the child(ren) are unaccompanied by an adult. All GUEST children, regardless of age, are required to be accompanied by an adult and are not granted this privilege. At the discretion of the lifeguard, a qualifying swim test may be administered to any child.

2. If you are providing permission, please provide the information indicated below.
3. You should check the "Not Allowed" box, for any specific child in this age group you are denying this privilege.
4. Please list all children, whether approving or denying this privilege.
